

# Questions & Answers

## Why do I need to call now?

Appointment times in the summer fill up fast. Seniors who call later on miss all the early summer specials and risk missing their yearbook deadline. Calling early ensures a good time slot for your session and once it's done, you can relax and enjoy the rest of your summer.

## What about my yearbook photo?

One free yearbook photo of your choice will be provided to your school's specifications only after your portrait order is placed. Additional photos, if needed will be \$5 each. Please do not wait until the last minute to order. A rush fee of \$10 will be added to your order if placed less than 3 weeks before your yearbook deadline.

## What about retouching?

Retouching will remove blemishes and soften facial lines, but will not remove glare on glasses, strap marks, out of place hair or clothing or an unshaven beard. Retouching is included in all of our portrait packages, or is added to the a la carte pricing for a charge of \$12 per pose. Extensive retouching is available at an additional charge.

## What if I wear glasses?

If you normally wear glasses, wear them for your portrait, but have the lenses removed or obtain a pair of empty frames just like yours from your optometrist. It is difficult and expensive to remove glass glare from photographs.

## What about a guarantee?

At Dan Grevas Photography you won't have to worry about how your portraits turn out. We go that extra mile to create a portrait that gives you the look that's right for you. Your satisfaction is guaranteed. All portraits are printed on Kodak professional grade portrait paper for a lasting memory.

## What should I bring to my session?

Bring all of the accessories for your outfits, such as simple jewelry, etc. Bring any props such as jerseys, letter jackets, musical instruments or your favorite hat...anything that expresses your unique style. If you'd like, bring along your favorite CD to listen to during your session. We want you to feel comfortable and most of all have fun!

## Where is the studio located?

Dan Grevas Photography is conveniently located just one block south of I-494 at 1100 South Concord Street. An easy drive from anywhere in the Southeast Metro. Take I-494 to the Concord Street exit. Turn south on Concord and we are one block ahead on the right.



## What about make-up and grooming?

Here are some suggestions for great looking portraits!

**Gals:** You may need to wear a little more make-up than normal for your session and lipstick is recommended. We will help you apply more make-up if needed. Please avoid wearing lip gloss, frosted eye shadow and face or body glitter.

**Guys:** Be sure to have a clean shave for your portraits. Razor stubble cannot be retouched. Also, we recommend that you use hair gel sparingly. Too much can make your hair look wet.

## What shall I wear?

Solid colors in medium to dark tones look best. Avoid large prints or patterns that detract from your face. Choose long sleeved shirts over short-sleeved. Wrinkles will show on your photos. Iron your clothes and carry them into the studio on a hanger. If you're unsure of what to wear, bring extra outfits and we'll help you decide what will look best.

## How do I place my order?

Parents, when you or your senior comes in to pick up their proof book, we will schedule another appointment within the next 10 days for you to order your finished portraits. Please check your schedule before picking up your proof book. Proofs cannot be checked out without a pre-payment and an appointment to place your order. Sorry, no exceptions.

## What if it rains?

If it rains, please keep your appointment as planned. We will do your studio session on that day. We have found that some summer days clear up quickly and we may be able to shoot outdoors after finishing your indoor session. If weather does not cooperate, we will reschedule your outdoor session for another day.

## Can I get my picture taken with my pet?

Absolutely! Your pet will look great in our studio garden! These photos are typically done at the beginning of your session(s), and someone must be available to bring your pet home when you are finished with your Activities session. Please note: Pets are not allowed in the studio and must be photographed outdoors.

## How can I save money on my portraits?
